BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW 119

WHEREAS subsection 147(1) of The Municipal Act S.M. 1996, c. 58 provides:

"The power to pass a by-law under this or any other Act includes the power to amend or repeal the by-law."

AND WHEREAS subsection 147(2) of the said Act further provides:

"The amendment or repeal of a by-law is subject to the same requirements that apply to passing the by-law, unless this or any other Act expressly provides otherwise."

AND WHEREAS it is deemed in the best interest of the Municipality to amend By-law No. 119 of the Municipality of Harrison Park;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Municipality of Harrison Park in open session duly assembled enacts as follows:

- 1. **THAT** By-Law No. 119, as amended, of the Municipality of Harrison Park **BE AND THE SAME IS HEREBY FURTHER AMENDED** as follows:
- a) Clause 31 to include:
 - d) Install a NoiseAware system into the dwelling
 - e) Not permit the use of outdoor televisions or stereos
 - f) Provide a property manager who will be available to respond to phone calls within 15 minutes 24 hours a day during the period of any guest stay and must live within 15 kilometres of the premises
 - g) Post contact name and phone number for owner(s) in a visible location on the front lawn
 - h) Pass a fire safety inspection
 - i) Observe quiet time as per the current municipal noise by-law.
 - j) If applicable, not permit hot tub use or outdoor fires during quiet time
 - k) Observe the maximum of 1 vehicle per bedroom of on-site parking for guests
