Public Hearing Commonly Asked Questions

Why did I receive this notice?

Section 169 of *The Planning Act*, requires that owners of property located within 100 meters of the affected property receive a copy of the notice of the hearing.

What is the main objective of the hearing?

At the time and date of the hearing, the Chairperson will ask the applicant to speak about the application and then Council may ask questions. After that the Chairperson will ask if anyone would like to speak for or against the application.

This is your opportunity to make representations to Council regarding the proposed application.

When the hearing is concluded, there are no further chances for anyone to speak to the Council of this matter.

Do I have to attend the hearing?

Your attendance at the Public Hearing is welcomed, however, you are not required to attend.

What if I have objections?

Objections can be raised in person at the public hearing or by submitting the objections in writing to:
