## THE MUNICIPALITY OF HARRISON PARK BY-LAW NO. 43

BEING A BY-LAW TO ENSURE THE INSTALLATION, MAINTENANCE AND LEGIBILITY OF CIVIC ADDRESSING SIGNS WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF HARRISON PARK

WHEREAS L.M. 1996 C. 58 – Chap. M225 Section 232(1)(b) & (e) states in part as follows:

- 232(1) A council may pass by-laws for municipal purposes respecting the following matters.
  - (a) the safety, health, protection and well-being of people, and the safety and protection of property;
  - (b) municipal roads, including naming the roads, posting the names on public or private property, and numbering lots and buildings along the roads;
  - (c) property adjacent to highways or municipal roads, whether the property is publicly or privately owned;

**AND WHEREAS** L.M. 1996 c. 58-Chap. M225 Section 236(1)(b)(iii) states in part as follows;

- 236(1) Without limiting the generality of clause 232(1)(o) (enforcement of by-laws) a by-law passed under that clause may include provisions
  - (b) remedying contravention of by-laws, including
    (iii) providing that an amount owing under
    subclause (ii) may be collected in any
    manner in which a tax may be collected or
    enforced under this Act.

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the Municipality of Harrison Park, in meeting duly assembled, enacts as follows:

For properties within the rural area of the Municipality of Harrison Park:

- 1. **THAT** the Municipality shall install the post and number sign, in such a manner that the numbers be visible from the municipal or provincial road;
- 2. **THAT** the initial cost of installation of the post and number sign be the responsibility of the Municipality;
- 4. **THAT** the numbering system signs erected by the Municipality be kept in a legible condition at all times;
- 5. **THAT** the blade of the sign be perpendicular to the ground;
- 6. **THAT** the number sign be placed off the edge of the municipal right-of-way;
- 7. **THAT** the numbering system signs erected by the Municipality be kept free of obstructions (including snow drift) and in plain view at all times;
- 8. **THAT** numbering system signs and posts shall be the property of the Municipality;
- 9. **THAT** the property owner be responsible to immediately notify the Municipality if a numbering sign or post is damaged or missing;

- 10. **THAT** the maintenance and repair of the numbering sign and post be the responsibility of the Municipality;
- 11. **THAT** the cost of maintenance and repair of the numbering sign and post be the responsibility of the property owner to which the numbering sign and post is assigned;
- 12. **THAT** if a property owner requests a sign be placed on a non-designated site or abandoned farm site the cost of the sign, post and installation shall be the responsibility of the property owner.
- 12. **THAT** the property owner be given 30 days notice to make payment upon presentation of an invoice for the costs of the maintenance and repair of the numbering sign and post. Failure to make payment within the 30 days specified will result in an outstanding debt to the Municipality and can be collected in the same manner as a tax may be collected or enforced under *The Municipal Act*.

For properties within the communities of Newdale, Sandy Lake, and Onanole, and all cottage subdivisions in the Municipality:

- 1. **THAT** house numbers shall be installed by the homeowner in a location clearly visible from the municipal or provincial road;
- 2. **THAT** the costs of the house numbers shall be the responsibility of the property owner;
